Prerequisite:

Students must be full-time, commissioned peace officers.

Course Description:

This five-day, 40-hour course of instruction is designed to meet the immediate training needs of officers who have an interest in being assigned to a narcotics unit, are scheduled to be assigned, or are currently assigned to a narcotics units. This course is intended to provide officers with information and practical skills needed to conduct drug investigations in today's ever-changing environment. It will also provide a formal understanding of how to conduct various types of drug investigations, from case initiation to sentencing of the defendant. Students will be exposed to the latest methods and investigative techniques.

Veteran narcotics investigators will present an overview of drug investigations and undercover operations. Topics will include drug identification, current drug threats, money laundering, medical marijuana, diversion of prescription drugs, Title III investigations, and associated legal issues and case law to assist officers in the field and in the courtroom. Officers will also receive basic guidance in undercover investigations and in the development, use, and control of confidential informants.

Who Should Attend:

Criminal investigators, narcotics/vice investigators, patrol officers interested in a career development program in drug enforcement. This course is a mandatory prerequisite to attend the AZ HIDTA Advanced Drug Investigation Course.

Continuing Education Hours:

40 hours Arizona Police Officers Standards and Training Board.
