

ACJC sub grantees:

As many of you are aware, the federal government shutdown has an impact on the availability of resources in the form of federal reimbursements to ACJC. We have received guidance from the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs (DOJ/OJP) that work under current contracts may continue; however, access to federal reimbursements will be delayed until the federal government resumes work.

Not all ACJC funded projects are affected by the shutdown. Byrne/JAG projects (including CJRIP) as well as all state funded projects are **not** impacted by the shutdown and reimbursements will be processed as normal. Other federally funded projects like NCHIP, NICS, DNA Backlog, Coverdell, Cold Case, ID the Missing, RSAT, PSN and VOCA are impacted by the shutdown. Reimbursements for these projects will be processed as soon as ACJC has access to federal funds.

Please continue to submit required monthly or quarterly financial and programmatic reports per your grant agreement. ACJC staff is committed to working with you during this challenging time.
