The Committee approve the 2020-2023 Drug, Gang and Violent Crime Control Strategy Goals.

**DISCUSSION:**

The current 2016-2019 strategy calls for an approach to addressing drug, gang, and violent crime, with a particular focus on the supply and demand for illicit drugs. Goals of the DGVCC program have been developed based on the scope of the problem, parameters of funding sources, and review of overarching drug control strategies. The goals for the current strategy are (1) curtail the flow of illicit drugs, drug proceeds and instruments used to perpetuate violence across Arizona, and (2) reduce violent crime, reduce illicit drug use, and deter repeat offenders in Arizona.
